



VULNERABLE POPULATION REGISTRY

Emergencies can occur at any time of the year, whether it is a fire, flood, tornado, or hazardous material spill.

Individuals can register with Clay County Public Health for special assistance during an emergency event.

The information in this registry is protected under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) and is only to be used during an emergency by Clay County Public Health and Clay County Emergency Management.

Family members and case workers can complete the registry for an individual who is considered vulnerable.

- Behaviorally or mentally disabled
- Frail or Elderly
- Homeless
- Limited or Non-English Speaking
- Medically or Chemically Dependent
- People Who Feel They Cannot Comfortably Safely Access and Use Standard Resources Offered in a Disaster
- Physically Disabled
- Young Children
- Other Vulnerable Individuals
