



## CLAY COUNTY 4-H Grant Program

### ABOUT THE GRANTS

Clay County 4-H Board of Directors offers a grant opportunity to Clay County 4-H clubs or groups. Since 2005, the Clay County 4-H Grant Program has awarded \$25,000 to support 36 projects. Individual amounts are not awarded for more than \$1,000 and the sum of all projects will not exceed \$4,000. In 2014, Proposals will be accepted through February 2, 2014, and awarded by Feb. 15th. First priority is given to projects not previously funded through this granting source. However, the Board of Directors also considers previously funded projects. The Board prefers typed applications following the format on the reverse side.

### EXAMPLES OF FUNDED PROJECTS

In 2013, grants were awarded to Food Stand Committee for Food Stand improvements, SET for an iPad, Livestock Committee for barn improvements, Horse Committee for a Horse Literacy Program and a Photography Community Service Project.

### PROGRAM FOCUS

The goal of the Clay County 4-H Grant Program is to fund youth development programs or projects that

- Provide service to community,
- Support educational programming, and
- Encourage youth and adults to work together.

### HOW TO APPLY (BY FEBRUARY 2, 2014)

A one page application is required. The application can be found on reverse side of sheet as well as on the county website. Applications should be typed or neatly written. Youth are encouraged to have a major role in completing the application.
