Clay County Deputy Ryan Carey and his Police K-9 partner Cuda competed in the 2010 U.S.P.C.A. Region 18 Police Canine Regional Trials held in Rochester MN, June 19th through June 21st, 2010.


Deputy Carey and K-9 Cuda again received top honors during this Recertification/Trials.

Deputy Carey and K-9 Cuda won **four** different awards during this competition:

 **Kojak Memorial Award:** This is a traveling trophy for 1st Place in Criminal Apprehension. This is the second time Deputy Carey and K-9 Cuda have won this award.

 **1st Place** in Criminal Apprehension. Deputy Carey and K-9 Cuda scored 338.17 out of 340 possible points.

 **2nd Place Overall** out of 82 K-9s that participated. Deputy Carey and K-9 Cuda scored 694.17 out of 700 overall points.

 **1st Place** in the 4 K-9 Combined Team Score, one team member was Moorhead Police Officer Justin Vogel and his K-9 partner Duke.
