## Deputy Ryan Carey and K-9 Cuda Receive Top Honors June 19 - 21, 2010



- ↑ Place in Criminal Apprehension. Deputy Carey and K-9 Cuda scored 338.17 out of 340 possible points.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Place Overall out of 82 K-9s that participated. Deputy Carey and K-9 Cuda scored 694.17 out of 700 overall points.
- 1<sup>st</sup> Place in the 4 K-9 Combined Team Score, one team member was Moorhead Police Officer Justin Vogel and his K-9 partner Duke.
