Clay County Deputy Ryan Carey and his Police K-9 partner Cuda competed in the 2008 U.S.P.C.A. Region 18 Police Canine Trials held in Detroit Lakes, Minnesota on June 16 and 17, 2008.

Deputy Carey and K-9 Cuda received Top Honors during the recertification/trials. There were 90 Police K-9s from three states competing in the trials.

Deputy Carey and K-9 Cuda won **five** different awards during this competition:



-  **Top Rookie Dog:** Out of the 90 dogs competing there were 19 rookie dogs. This is the first trial that these dogs have competed in. Deputy Carey and K-9 Cuda received the Top Rookie Dog Award.
-  **Kojak Memorial Award:** This is a traveling trophy for 1<sup>st</sup> Place in Criminal Apprehension.
-  **1<sup>st</sup> Place** in Criminal Apprehension. K-9 Cuda scored 338.5 out of 340 possible points.
-  **3<sup>rd</sup> Place** in Suspect Search.
-  **5<sup>th</sup> Place Overall** out of 90 K-9s that participated. K-9 Cuda scored 681.33 out of 700 overall points.
